The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India regarding which a representation dated 07.12.2019 has been given by the petitioner to respondent No. 3- Senior Superintendent of Police in which the primary prayer of the petitioner is for registration of the FIR against the private respondents No. 5 to 8.

Faced with the dictum of law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in case titled **Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P. and others, reported as 2008(2) SCC 409** and in **M. Subramaniam and another Vs. S.
