(The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.)

The petitioners, who are living in live-in-relationship, have filed the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from danger at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned State counsel has submitted that statements of the petitioners were recorded by ASI Jaswant Singh on 09.02.2021 and the petitioners stated therein that they did not have any apprehension of danger to their life and liberty and did not require any action for protection of their life and liberty.

In support of his submissions, learned State counsel has sent short reply by way of affidavit of Sukhpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), District Gurdaspur on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 along with copies of statements of the petitioners

recorded by ASI Jaswant Singh through e-mail, print out of which are taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of the statements made by the petitioners, they do not want to continue with the present petition and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn.
