SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of private respondent No.6.

Counsel for the petitioner has contended that the husband of the petitioner and respondent No.6 are accused in FIR No.67 dated 15.11.2018, registered under Sections 406, 419, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station City Morinda, District Rupnagar (Annexure P-1). In December 2020, respondent No.6 came to the house of petitioners with musclemen and goons and threatened her that in case she discloses the whereabouts of respondent No.6, she and her son will be killed. Counsel submits that the petitioner apprehends threat to her life. Before approaching this Court,

petitioner submitted a representation dated 08.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) to the official respondents, seeking protection. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into his representation dated 08.12.2020 (Annexure P-2).

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali – respondent No.3 to examine the representation dated 08.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the representation dated 08.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) be communicated to respondent No.3 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
