This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.789 dated 10.12.2019 under Sections 34, 323, 379, 427, 452 & 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Camp Palwal, District Palwal. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 16.01.2020, whereby while issuing notice of motion to respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. The said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the brother of the petitioner lodged the FIR No.789 dated 10.12.2019, under Sections 34, 323, 379, 427, 452 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Camp Palwal against him, his father and other brothers. It is pointed out that the parties have resolved the dispute and have arrived at a

compromise. Further, reliance is placed upon the order dated 26.12.2019 (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion for 11.05.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M No.55594 of 2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Jamshed Ali does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 16.01.2020 is made absolute.
