LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

Prayer in this writ petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider representation dated 20.12.2019 (Annexure P-1). Allegations have been raised against respondent no.4 - Gram Panchayat regarding embezzlement of Panchayat's funds.

Reply of the BDPO - respondent no.3 on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3 has been filed, wherein it is specifically stated that inquiry has been conducted on the representation dated 20.12.2019. Inquiry report is attached as Annexure R1/T. Pursuant thereto order dated 19.03.2021 (Annexure R-2) has been passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Yamuna Nagar. No financial embezzlement has been found though financial irregularities were discovered.

Certain directions have been issued to ensure that future development work is carried out as per instructions/Rules laid down by the Government.

In view of order dated 19.03.2021, passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Yamuna Nagar, learned Counsel for the State submits that this writ petition is rendered infructuous, though, learned counsel for the petitioner contends order dated 19.03.2021 to be unjustified and incorrect.

Be that as it may, present writ petition merely seeks decision of representation dated 20.12.2019. Admittedly matter has been inquired into and order passed.

No further orders are called for in this case. Writ petition is accordingly is disposed of as infructuous.
