The petitioner- a proprietary concern is engaged in import and trading of Heavy Melting Scrap and Re-Rollable Steel Scrap from foreign suppliers. During the course of its business, it imported two consignments of heavy Melting Scrap from “Mozambique”.

Grievance of the petitioner is that despite its completing necessary formalities, including deposit of custom duty, imported goods are not being released, due to which it is liable to pay demurrage and detention charges to Port Authorities. Hence, the present writ petition *inter alia* for directing the respondents to permit clearance of goods imported vide Bills of Entries dated 28.12.2020 (Annexures P-2 and P-3).

Notice of motion was issued.

At the time of resumed hearing today, learned counsel for the petitioner state that the present writ petition has become infructuous as the goods in question have already been released by the Customs Authorities.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed as infructuous.
