Through this writ petition, filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner, who has filed the present writ petition through her natural guardian, prays for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to issue passport.

Ms. Shweta Nahata, Advocate, for the respondents submits that the present writ petition is pre-mature as her application is under consideration and the petitioner has not produced the relevant documents as required.

She further states that if the petitioner produces the relevant documents before the Passport Officer within one week, the Passport Officer will pass an appropriate order in accordance with law within two weeks thereafter.

Keeping in view the aforesaid stand, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this writ petition be disposed of by directing respondent No.2-Passport Officer to pass an appropriate order within two weeks after the petitioner produces the relevant documents.

It is clarified that if no document is produced or incomplete documents are produced, respondent No.2-Passport Officer shall be required to pass an order in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
