A connected appeal arising from the same accident i.e. FAO No.155 of 2021 has been dismissed by this Bench on 22.02.2021.

This Court has heard the learned counsel for the appellant. He submits that apart from the arguments made in the connected appeal, he wishes to dispute the apportionment of the compensation between the widow and the father of the deceased.

In the considered view of this Court, once neither the father nor the widow of the deceased has disputed the apportionment of the compensation then the Insurance Company has no *locus standi*. Still further, the widow has been granted compensation of an amount of Rs.50,00,000/-, whereas the father of the deceased has been awarded only a sum of Rs.5,90,000/-.

Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.
