This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner had sought a mandamus for directing the official respondents to look into the conduct of respondent No.5 i.e. a serving police official on the allegation that he had mis-used his official powers and thereby had removed articles from the house of the petitioner. Further allegations are that respondent No.5 has acted in connivance and at the behest of private respondent No.6 with whom there is a matrimonial dispute of the petitioner.

On the previous date of hearing, learned State counsel had been directed to complete instructions in the matter and particularly as regards the proposed action based upon an enquiry report dated 08.06.2020 at Annexure P-10/T.

During the course of resumed hearing today Mr. Gaurav Garg Dhuriwala, DAG, Punjab, upon instructions from ASI Raghbir Singh,

has apprised the Court that the SP, (PBI), Khanna has been entrusted the matter to look into the allegations against respondent No.5 and a time frame of two months has been fixed for completion of the enquiry.

In view of the stand taken on behalf of the State and steps having already been initiated to conduct a detailed enquiry against respondent No.5, no further directions are required to be passed in the instant writ petition.
