CRM-2801 of 2020

Present application has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for placing on record amended memo of parties as Sections 353, 186 IPC read with Section 3 of Prevention of Defacement of Property Act, 1985 were not added in the head note of the petition.

For the reasons enumerated in the application, the same is allowed and the amended petition is taken on record.

CRM-M-1654 of 2020

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.102 dated 15.11.2019, under Sections 323, 324, 307, 379-B, 295-A, 341, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 353, 186 IPC read with Section 3 of the Defacement of Property Act, 1985 were added later on), registered at Police Station

Kheri Gandain, District Patiala, Punjab.

Vide order dated 16.01.2020, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join investigation.

On instructions, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 16.01.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
