1. This order shall dispose off the aforesaid two petitions i.e. CRM-M-1433-2020 filed on behalf of Ramesh Kumar and CRM-M-2206-2020 filed on behalf of Sanjeev and Naresh seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against them vide FIR No.364 dated 19.12.2019 at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar, under Sections 148/149/452/323/325/341/506 IPC.

2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion in CRM-M-1433-2020 on 15.01.2020, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case where a false FIR has been lodged against the petitioner and the others as a counter blast to another FIR which was lodged against the complainant party at the instance of Sonam daughter of the petitioner wherein the petitioner sustained injuries.

Notice of motion for 17.4.2020.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in the instant case the parties have amicably resolved their issues and in fact a petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise i.e. CRM-M-35275-2020 has already been filed, which is presently fixed for 01.10.2021.
4. On the other hand, learned State counsel, while feigning ignorance about the compromise, has informed this Court that the petitioners pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court have since joined investigation and are not required for any custodial interrogation.
5. In view of the aforestated position wherein the parties are stated to have amicably resolved their issues and the petitioners are stated to have joined investigation and are not wanted in any other case, both the petitions are accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide orders dated 15.01.2020 in CRM-M-1433-2020 and 20.01.2020 in CRM-M-2206-2020 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating
