Petitioners have invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India seeking writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to to re-fix family pension of petitioners w.e.f. 01.12.2011 or date of entitlement alongwith consequential arrears @ 18% per annum of revised family pension and pensionary benefits @ 50% of the being drawn by the spouse.

Upon hearing counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed off with the directions to the respondent to

consider the legal notice dated 07.11.2020 of the petitioners as representation and decide the same fully in accordance with law by passing a speaking order expeditiously, preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
