Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.128 dated 25.06.2017 under Sections 409/420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sanoli, District Panipat.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 21.01.2020: -

“...Learned senior counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 04.11.2019 passed by the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana, vide which services of the petitioner has been reinstated. It is further submitted that without prejudice to his right of defence, the petitioner is ready to deposit a sum of Rs.5.00 lacs with the Illaqa Magistrate, to be kept in an FDR subject to final outcome of the case.

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Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajbir, submits that co-accused Gayur Ali was granted the concession of anticipatory bail vide order dated 16.10.2018 passed in CRM-M-28157-2018 and challan qua him stands presented...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation. It is further submitted that a period of about 01 year and 07 months has passed and there is no complaint against the petitioner that he has misused the concession of interim anticipatory bail. It is also submitted that the petitioner has also deposited the amount of Rs.5.00 lacs with the Illaqa Magistrate.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of reply by way of affidavit of DSP, Samalkha, Panipat, the order dated 20.02.2020 passed by the Illaqa Magistrate and on instructions from SI Karamvir Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 21.01.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
