The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. seeking an interim bail to the petitioner to perform the rituals and ceremonies of the death of his 2 years old daughter.

During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has disclosed that a similar application was filed before the learned trial Court and the same was also listed for today.

In the post lunch session, learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that he sought instructions from the counsel who is appearing before the trial Court that the trial Court has granted interim bail to the petitioner for 19.01.2021 to attend the Bhog ceremony for the period of six hours.

Further interim bail has also been granted from 19.01.2021 to 20.01.2021 for going to Haridawar.

In view of the above, no further proceedings are required to be called for in the present petition. Therefore, the present petition is dismissed.
