This is 2nd petition filed by the petitioner for grant of concession of regular bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.85, dated 08.11.2018, registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Later on Section 307 IPC has been added), at Police Station Harike , District Tarn Taran.

On 20.09.2019, the previous bail application filed by the petitioner bearing CRM-M-19242-2019, was dismissed with the following order:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.85, dated 8.11.2018, registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (offence under Section 307 IPC added later on), at Police Station Harike , District Tarn Taran.

Although the petitioner is in custody since November

2018, however, allegation against the petitioner are that he used a sharp edge sword type weapon which went through the thigh of the injured and his leg had to be amputated.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, petitioner does not deserve to be released on regular bail. The petition is dismissed. However, the trial Court is requested to make sincere endeavour to conclude the trial within a period of 9 months.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner, although made an attempt, however, failed to make out any fresh ground for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
