1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.208 dated 08.09.2020, registered under Section 346 IPC at Police Station City Jhajjar, District Jhajjar and would be satisfied, if the present petition is disposed of by directing the Superintendent of Police, Jhajjar to decide representation (Annexure P-2) dated 29.12.2020 submitted by the petitioner and to take action on the same as may be warranted in respect thereto in accordance with law.

3. Mr. Vivek Chauhan, learned Addl. A.G., Haryana, who is present in Court, states that he has no objection to the aforementioned limited prayer of the petitioner.

4. Accordingly, in the light of the position as noted above, the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is ***disposed of*** by directing Superintendent of Police, Jhajjar, to take a decision, on representation (Annexure P-2) dated 29.12.2020 submitted by the petitioner and thereafter take such action on the same as may be warranted in respect thereto in accordance with law within 04 weeks from today.
