The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 176, dated 02.09.2020, under Sections 365 & 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 19th January, 2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Satgur Singh, states that though the petitioner has joined investigation, however, he has not disclosed the whereabouts of the vehicle which was used in the crime in question.

Per contra, the aforesaid fact is disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 19th January, 2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
