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**B.S. Walia, J. (VC)**

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.122 dated 09.12.2016 registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala on the ground that despite cancellation report having been prepared by the Police on 12.01.2018, the same has not been presented before the learned trial Court till date.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Hittan Nehra, learned Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and on instructions from respondent No.2 states that cancellation report dated 12.01.2018 would be presented before the learned trial Court within 03 weeks from today.
6. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, he does not press the petition under

while directing respondent No.2 to adhere to the assurance given by the learned State Counsel and to present the cancellation report dated 12.01.2018 before the learned trial Court within 03 weeks from today.

7. In view of the position as noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is ***disposed of*** as not pressed, while directing respondent No.2 to present the cancellation report dated 12.01.2018 as per assurance held out by learned State Counsel before the learned trial Court within a period of 03 weeks from today.

8. Needless to mention, in case, needful is not done within the stipulated period of time, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek compliance by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law. It is further mentioned that in case, cancellation report is not accepted by the learned trial Court, it would be open to the petitioner to take out appropriate proceedings in respect thereto, in accordance with law.
