ARCHANA PURI, J.

The matter has been taken up through video conferencing in the light of COVID-19 pandemic.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioners for issuance of direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their lives and personal liberty, as they apprehend danger at the instance of private respondents No. 4 to 6, who are family members of petitioner No.2, namely, Jaya Dwivedi, on account of marriage having solemnized by them on 14.01.2021.

It is averred in the petition that both the petitioners are major and to so substantiate their claim, copies of Aadhar cards of both the petitioners are annexed with the petition. Even, photographs of marriage have also been annexed with the petition. They are residing within the jurisdiction of this Court. It is contended that representation dated 15.01.2021 has been filed by the petitioners before SSP, Jagraon, copy whereof is Annexure P-5, but no action has been initiated upon the same.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Sarabjit Singh Cheema, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents and gives assurance about initiation of action on the representation dated 15.01.2021, in accordance with law.

In view of the submission so made and the assurance so given by the learned State Counsel, the present petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 to consider the grievance of the petitioner, in view of the representation dated 15.01.2021, copy whereof is Annexure P-5 and to initiate action upon the same, in accordance with law, if so required, within a period of three weeks from today onwards.

However, these observations are circumscribed only for the purposes of disposal of the present petition, without prejudice to the rights of the parties, to be adjudicated in any civil or criminal proceedings, qua their age, factum of marriage and the validity thereof.
