Present civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for direction to the respondents to release the amount of ₹42,538/- on account of reimbursement of medical bills of the petitioner.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 21.01.2021, passed the following order:-

*“Inter alia contends that matter pertains to reimbursement of medical bills for the period w.e.f. 18.05.2019 to 25.01.2020.*

Today, learned counsel for respondent No.3, on instructions from the concerned quarter, has apprised the Court that entire payment of medical bills to the tune of ₹42,538/- has been reimbursed to the petitioner on 09.02.2021.

Since relief claimed by the petitioner has been granted by respondent No.3; thus, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter.

Consequently, the writ petition is disposed off as such.
