Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 278 dated 30.10.2019 registered under Section 346 IPC (Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B, 216 IPC and Section 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (**POCSO**) Act, 2012, were added later on), at Police Station Hassanpur, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that FIR was lodged on the complaint of Anil Kumar, alleging therein that his daughter, aged 17 years, had eloped with the petitioner and she had also taken away some cash and jewellery.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file the bail petition after the statements of complainant as well as prosecutrix, have been recorded before the learned trial Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
