This is an application for placing on record additional  
documents i.e. orders dated 02.03.2021 and 02.04.2021.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the  
same is allowed and the accompanying documents are taken on  
record i.e. Annexure P-6 collectively, subject to all just  
exceptions.

**Main case**

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section

439 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.158 dated 09.08.2020 under Sections 379-A, 411 IPC registered at Police Station Rajound, Kaithal (Haryana).

FIR was registered at the instance of complainant Nehal Gupta. On 09.08.2020, when she was leaving her room for going to the hospital at about 7.35 PM and reached Guga Maidi, Kaithal road, then two boys came on a motorcycle and snatched her mobile phone. The complainant could not see the number of motorcycle. She gave description of the boys in terms of wearing apparels. She also gave two SIM numbers of the mobile, IEMI number and brand number.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner who was arrested on 18.11.2020. Petitioner has not been named in the FIR. The motorcycle in question is the subject matter of theft in another case in which petitioner has been granted bail by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kaithal vide order dated 02.04.2021.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner has been implicated in the present case on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Vishal who has been granted regular bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, Kaithal vide order dated 02.03.2021. These orders have been brought on record by way of Annexure P-6.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mukesh Kumar submits that challan has already been presented, but charges have not been framed so far.

At this stage, without meaning anything on the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

In view of above, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.
