Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.133 dated 02.12.2018, under Section 304-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City-II, Abohar, District Fazilka.

Vide order dated 27.08.2021, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 27.08.2021, petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagjeet Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 27.08.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
