The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.181, dated 09.08.2019 (wrongly typed 09.06.2019 in the Ld. Lower Court) registered under Section 21 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

Vide order dated 22.01.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Dalwinderbir Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation. He has further instructions to state that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 22.01.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
