The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.0273 dated 07.11.2019 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 506 and 34 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station South Sector-34, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of interim direction issued in favour of the petitioner on 04.02.2020, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned APP UT, Chandigarh on instructions from SHO Rajiv Sharma and Inspector Bhagwat Dyal submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation. He further submits that

the challan has been prepared by the investigating agency and that stands approved by the competent authority. In every likelihood, the challan shall be filed in the Court very soon. Petitioner is not required for any further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 04.02.2020 is made absolute. However, petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
