The petitioners have invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant the benefits of same pay scale and pensionary benefits to the petitioner as their counterparts working in the Soil Conservation Department of the State of Punjab on the basis of the letter dated 23.07.1997 (Annexure P-5) as directed by this Hon'ble Court and the petitioner be granted all the consequential benefits such as fixation of pay, arrears of pay etc for which the petitioner is legally entitled along with interest @18% per annum.

Ms. Simran Grewal, AAG, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State. Copy supplied.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the legal notices dated 27.05.2019 (Annexure P-7) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
