Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.227 dated 22.11.2020 under Section 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of complainant Renu Gupta, when she was returning home, some unknown persons came from behind and snatched her purse, which was containing two mobile phones. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in custody for the last about one and half month and is not involved in any other case. It is also submitted that the matter has been settled between

the parties and relies upon the compromise dated 14.01.2021 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for respondent No.2-complainant has acknowledged that matter stands compromised between the parties.

Learned State counsel has also not disputed the factual position.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
