The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.59 dated 30.06.2019, under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station GRP Hisar, District GRP Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a cousin of Jyoti while co-accused Anil is her husband. Anil and Jyoti had married on 25.06.2019. The deceased wanted to get married to Jyoti and was upset on account of her marriage to Anil. It is mentioned in the alleged suicide note that the deceased was in love with Jyoti for the last 10 years. The petitioner is in custody for almost 03 months since his arrest on 29.10.2020. He also contends that the allegations in the FIR and the suicide note would not prima facie constitute an offence under Section 306 IPC.

Learned State counsel upon instructions states that the challan has been filed but no prosecution witnesses have been examined.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for almost 03 months, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
