Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.461 dated 03.12.2020 registered under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC at Police Station Zirakpur, SAS Nagar, Punjab.

By virtue of the order dated 06.04.2021, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

The parties were referred to the Mediation Centre vide order dated 07.07.2021. I have interacted with both the counsel for the parties and it has been concluded from the arguments that the matter cannot be settled amicably and the same is to be decided on merits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 06.04.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel affirms the same and submits that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 06.04.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
