On 21.01.2021, the following order was passed:-

“Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner assails correctness of the order dated 14.01.2021, transferring him from Karnal to Kosli(Rewari).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already applied for voluntary retirement, which is pending approval. He also alleges malafide against respondent no.6-MLA-cum-Chairman, Haryana Tourism Department.

Notice of motion.

On the request of this Court, Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG,

Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.1 to 4 and prays for a short adjournment to get the complete instructions.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner shall not be forced to join at the new place of posting”

Mr. Samarth Sagar, Addl. A.G. Haryana, on instructions from Mr. Abhishek Sher, Assistant Executive Engineer, Public Health and Engineering Department, Haryana, submits that the order of transfer dated 14.01.2021 transferring the petitioner from Karnal to Kosli (Rewari), shall not be implemented till the decision is taken on his application for voluntary retirement. He submits that the decision will be taken on his application for voluntary retirement within a period of one month.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such. However, the petitioner will be permitted to work at Karnal in view of the statement made by Mr. Samarth Sagar, Addl. A.G. Haryana.
