The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner prays for the following substantive reliefs:-

“i) Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the Respondent, to grant an opportunity to allow the petitioner for verification of original documents, pursuant to Advertisement No.12/2019 dated 20.07.2019 (Annexure P-1), for the post of Librarian (General Category), for which, the final selection list is yet to be declared.”

The petitioner applied for the post of Librarian in response to a recruitment notice dated 20.07.2019. The petitioner appeared for the written examination and successfully cleared the same. However, due to imposition of lock-down, she could not attend the meeting held for scrutiny of her testimonials.

Ms. Kirti Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, on instructions from Mr. Dikansh Goyal, Legal Assistant, Haryana Staff

Selection Commission, has submitted that the Haryana Staff Selection Commission has decided to grant an opportunity to the petitioner to come for scrutiny of the documents. She further submits that this decision has been taken in view of the facts and circumstances of the present case and shall not be treated as precedent.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous. However, the respondent shall remain bound by the aforesaid statement.
