1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.134 dated 14.10.2019 registered under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC (Section 494 IPC added lateron) at Women Police Station, Sector 17, Chandigarh.

2. By an order dated 17.01.2020, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of U.T. Chandigarh, on instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh, submits that petitioner has joined investigation.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.
