B.S. Walia, J. (VC)

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for permission to withdraw the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., with liberty to the petitioners to surrender before the learned trial Court, to file an application for regular bail before the learned trial Court and directions being issued to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the petition for regular bail, in a time bound manner.

3. Without commenting on the merits of the case and in view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty as prayed for. In the eventuality of an application for regular bail being filed before the learned trial Court, the learned trial Court is directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within one week.
