Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that though, the petitioner is challenging orders Annexures P/1 to P/3 in the present writ petition but, he is not pressing for the relief qua the restoration of the Khal. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that not only the temporary Khal is being restored but, the same is being made pucca and that too without following the due procedure of law. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that as per law there is a certain procedure to be followed in case, a temporary Khal is to be made pucca.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that the petitioner be given liberty to approach the respondents raising the grievance that restored Khal is being made pucca without following the procedure as envisaged under law by filing an appropriate representation before respondent No.2

and the said respondent be directed to take cognizance of the said representation and pass an appropriate order on the same.

Mr. Sharad Aggarwal, AAG, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition submits that in case, any representation is made by the petitioner raising the grievance that the restored Khal is being made pucca without following procedure as envisaged under the law, the same will be considered by respondent No.2 and an appropriate order will be passed in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned counsel for the respondents, he does not press the present writ petition any further and the same may be disposed of as such.

The present writ petition is disposed of.
