This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to take action against respondents No.5 and 6 for committing fraud by unlawfully withdrawing the amount of the Society for personal use by misappropriating the funds and salary withdrawn by fake documents on the basis of investigation report dated 05.11.2018 (Annexure P/4) and inquiry report dated 23.07.2019 (Annexure P/5).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation dated 26.05.2018 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/3, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. H.S Sitta, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to look into and decide representation dated 26.05.2018 (Annexure P/3) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within two months positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
