By this petition, i.e. CRM-M-2965 of 2021, quashing, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners (accused) and respondents no.2 to 4, is sought, of FIR No.250, dated 14.06.2020, registered at Police Station Sector 32-33, District Karnal, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323 and 506 of the IPC.

By this petition, i.e. CRM-M-3135 of 2021, quashing of FIR No.252, dated 14.06.2020, is sought, both on the basis of a compromise arrived at between

the petitioners (accused) and respondents no.2 to 5, as has been registered at the same police station, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 323 and 506 of the IPC, read with Section 34 thereof,

Pursuant to the order of this court dated 22.01.2021, the report of the learned CJM, Karnal, dated 08.03.2021, is on record, stating to the effect that the statements of the parties, i.e. the petitioners and respondents no.2 to 4 (in CRM-M-2965 of 2021) and respondents no.2 to 5 (in CRM-M-3135 of 2021) have been recorded, in respect of the compromise reached.

As regards her own opinion on the genuineness of the compromise reached, it is stated by the CJM that as per the statements of the parties, the compromise has been arrived at without any kind of undue influence or pressure.

In view of the above, with learned counsel appearing for the parties obviously also not refuting the compromise even today, looking at the nature of the offences, both these petitions are allowed, with FIR No.250, dated 14.06.2020, registered at Police Station Sector 32-33, District Karnal, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323 and 506 of the IPC, and FIR No.252, dated 14.06.2020, registered at the same police station for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 323 and 506 of the IPC, read with Section 34 thereof, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, are hereby quashed.

A copy of this order be also placed on the file of the other connected matter too.
