The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

On 22.01.2020, the following order was passed:-

This is second application for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 129 dated 02.09.2019, registered under Sections 341, 324, 323, 148 & 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC was added lateron), at Police Station Bikhi, District Mansa.

Taking note of the fact that learned counsel for the petitioner had contended that the parties have resolved their dispute and a deed of settlement has been reduced into writing, learned counsel representing the State was requested to verify the facts and assist.

Mr. S.P.S.Tinna, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, on instructions from Head Constable Satbir Singh, has confirmed this fact.

Notice of motion for 23.03.2020.

Mr. Bhupinder Singh Chahal, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of the first informant and endorses the stand taken by the petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, petitioner is directed to join the investigation. In the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be listed for hearing along with CRM-M-1348-2020.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Paramjit

Singh, has informed the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation,

and has cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 22.01.2020 is made absolute.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
