The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.87 dated 18.09.2019, under Sections 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged in the FIR that the petitioner had taken money from the complainant for sending him abroad. He, however, contends that without prejudice to his rights and contentions, the petitioner is willing to pay a sum of ₹1.50 lacs which were allegedly paid by the complainant to the father and brother-in-law of the petitioner.

Heard.

This is the second petition for anticipatory bail preferred by the petitioner. The first petition bearing CRM-M-9751-2020 was dismissed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court on 05.03.2020. It is noticed in the order dated 05.03.2020 that when the petitioner did not fulfill the promise of sending the complainant abroad, the matter was compromised with the petitioner agreeing

to pay a sum of ₹7,49,000/- to the complainant but this amount was not paid. The petitioner is promising to return only a part of the amount which he had allegedly agreed to return earlier, therefore, I do not intend to take another view in the matter at this stage.

The petition stands dismissed at this stage.
