Through the instant petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 the petitioner is seeking grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No.641 dated 23.10.2020 (Annexure P-1) registered under Section 379-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station, City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

In compliance of the order dated 27.01.2021, the State has filed a reply/status report by way of affidavit dated 13.02.2021 of Aryan Chaudhary, Deputy Superintendent of Police, HQ, Sirsa through an email. The same is taken on record. The Registry is directed to tag the same at the appropriate place.

As per the said reply/status report, the petitioner is shown to be involved in two other case FIRs similar to the case in hand. Learned counsel for the State has apprised the Court that the petitioner has committed the

crime in the present case while he was on bail in other two case FIRs registered against him.

In the circumstances, this Court is not inclined to extend the concession of regular bail to the petitioner and hence, the instant petition is hereby dismissed as such. However, it is clarified that any observation made hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression on the merits of the case.
