RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the petition
is taken on Board.

This petition has been filed by the petitioner being aggrieved by
the proceedings taken up by the Registration Committee under the
Insecticides Act, 1968 (for short 'the Act') considering the case of
respondents No.5 and 6 for grant of Provisional Registration Certificate or
otherwise. During the pendency of this petition and in terms of the interim
orders passed by this Court, the matter was reviewed by the Registration
Committee and has now passed the order on 2.9.2021, by rejecting the
petitioner's representation against the consideration of the application filed

by respondents No.6 and 7 for provisional registration.

Learned Senior counsel appearing for respondents No.6 submits that the respondent(s) application filed under Section 9(3-B) of the Act for grant of provisional registration certificate is still pending before the authority(s).

Apparently, the authority(s) is yet to take a final decision on the application filed by respondent(s) under Section 9 (3-B) of the Act. And the representation filed by the petitioner has since been rejected by the authority(s) vide order dated 02.09.2021, the petitioner has a remedy under Section 11 of the Act by way of revision against that order. Therefore, without entering into the controversy and making any comments in that regard the petition filed by the petitioner is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to assail the order dated 02.09.2021, passed by the authority(s) in accordance with law before the Forum prescribed.
