The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.240 dated 07.10.2015, under Sections 279, 337, 338, 427, 304A IPC, registered at Police Station Phillaur, district Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was on regular bail but as the matter had been compromised, he had gone abroad and was declared as a proclaimed offender.

Heard through video conferencing.

The petitioner is alleged to be involved in a road accident in the year 2015. He was granted bail but he had absconded himself from the proceedings on 25.05.2016. He was subsequently declared as a proclaimed offender. He has preferred the application for anticipatory bail after over 04 years. As the petitioner had fled from justice and was declared as a proclaimed offender, I do not find any good ground to grant him the concession of anticipatory bail. The petition stands dismissed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner shall surrender before the trial Court within a week and prefer an application for regular bail.

In the event of the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court within a period of one week from now and preferring an application for regular bail, the same shall be decided in accordance with law expeditiously.
