The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail on behalf of the Petitioner in case FIR No.243, dated 05.08.2019, registered under Sections 342, 365 (Section 394 deleted subsequently and Sections 395, 201, 412 of the IPC added later on during investigation) and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Khol, District Rewari, Haryana.

2. The Petitioner was not named in the FIR.
3. He was not even identified by the Complainant during the Test Identification Parade as can be seen from the Report dated 30.10.2020 of the Ld. Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rewari (Annexure P-2).
4. The only incriminating material against the Petitioner has come-forth from the Disclosure Statement of the co-accused namely Amit

Kumar Dara, who has already been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M No.37860 of 2020 on 24.11.2020. However, the Petitioner has remained in custody for almost 04 months since 21.10.2020.

5. Investigation against the Petitioner has already been completed and Challan submitted.

6. In the circumstances, further detention of the Petitioner for an indefinite period at this stage is not called for. As such, he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
