The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking quashing of impugned order/letter dated 22.09.2019 (Annexure P-3), passed by respondent No.5; and for issuance of a direction to the respondents not to change the nature of the pond/*johar* land into a park and *chaupal*.

Learned counsel states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, in case, respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 10.02.2020 (Annexure P-4), already moved by the petitioner, expeditiously, in a time-bound manner.

In view of the prayer made, we are not inclined to issue notice of motion. However, a complete copy of the paper-book has already been supplied to learned State counsel.

Accordingly, without advertng to the merits of the case, respondent No.2-The Deputy Commissioner, Jhajjar, is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 10.02.2020 (Annexure P-4) expeditiously, preferably, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, as per law.
