The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.323 dated 22.12.2020, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of his brother from whom 06 grams of heroin was allegedly recovered. He further contends that there is no other case under the NDPS Act pending against the petitioner.

This Court, by the order dated 22.01.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kishori Lal, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 22.01.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
