A letter has been placed on record by learned State counsel from the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Rewari dated 07.02.2021 wherein it has been stated that with the help of police force of SHO, Police Station Rampura, blockage from the disputed street has been removed and waste water has been drained. Presently, there is no blockage on the street and the construction of the street with proper drainage system would be completed within a period of 15 days.
