The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Heard review applicant in person. On 11.09.2020, learned counsel representing the review applicant admitted that the orders passed by the competent authority under Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 were without jurisdiction.

This Bench has interacted with the petitioner. He does not dispute that he is getting a monthly pension of more than Rs.29,000/-. However, he states that he has been thrown out of the house. As noticed in the order dated 17.07.2020, the writ petitioner is also co-owner of the property in dispute and proceedings for partition of the joint property have not initiated yet. Hence, no ground to review the order dated 11.09.2020 is made out.

Hence, dismissed.
