The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.526 dated 20.12.2019, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 325, 506 IPC (Section 452 IPC added during investigation), registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court on 18.02.2020 had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there was a matrimonial dispute between Chand Singh and Bhupinder Kaur, who is the sister of petitioner. When the petitioner had gone to rescue his nephew, who was near the house of Chand Singh, a fight erupted between the complainant party and petitioner. He further submits that in the fight, even the complainant party was inflicted injuries.

List on 30.03.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from PSI Vinod, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 18.02.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
