The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

As per the office report, notice issued to the respondent through trial Court counsel has been received back served.

However, the respondent remains unrepresented.

On 12.08.2021, the following order was passed:-

“The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner prays for advancing the date of hearing in an application seeking transfer of the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (HMA/215/2020) by the respondent (husband) titled as “Vinod Kumar Vs. Sarita”, from the Court of Principal Judge (Family Court), Narnaul to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Charkhi Dadri.

Notice of motion was issued for 25.03.2021.

As per the office report, the notice issued to the respondent was received back served through his father. However, on 25.03.2021, the case was not taken up. As per the record, the respondent has not entered appearance.

For the reasons stated in the application, the date of hearing is preponed to 27.08.2021.

Since, the respondent has not entered appearance, therefore, let another attempt be made to serve the respondent through his counsels Sh. S.K. Sharma and Sh. Rajesh K. Madhogarhiya, in District Court Narnaul, Camp Court at Mahendergarh.”

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

For the reasons recorded in the order dated 12.08.2021, the application is allowed.

The file of case bearing No.HMA215/2020, titled as “Vinod Kumar Vs. Sarita”, pending in the Court of Principal Judge (Family Court), Narnaul, is orderd to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Charkhi Dadri.

The petitioner through her counsel is directed to appear before the transferee Court on 10.09.2021.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
