The matter has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

This order shall dispose of two petitions i.e. ***CRM-M-3269-2021*** titled as ***Kanta Devi and another Vs. State of Haryana*** and ***CRM-M-5977-2021*** titled as ***Rajan and State of Haryana and another***.

Prayer in both the petitions filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, in case FIR No. 121 dated 31.12.2020 registered under Sections 323, 354, 377, 406, 498-A, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Woman Police Station, Kurukshetra, District Kurukshetra.

Vide order dated 10.02.2021 passed in CRM-M-5977-2021, it being a matrimonial dispute between the parties, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre. Pursuant thereto, a report dated 19.02.2021 has been received from the Mediator wherein the matter has been settled between the parties and the settlement/agreement dated 19.02.2021 has been reduced in writing.

In view of the above, both the petitions are disposed of at this stage. Since the matter has been settled between the parties, the petitioners would not be arrested in these cases, unless clear 15 days notice is given to them.
