The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.557 dated 11.07.2019 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506 of IPC at Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat.

On 20.01.2020, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon inquiry report of the year 2017, wherein the issue in question was enquired by the police and it was found that the husband of the complainant was dealing with Virender Shaw of Nepal through M/s Siya Ram Woolen Industries, Panipat. On 11.11.2017, settlement was arrived at in the police station, wherein it was found that Virender Shaw of Nepal has to pay an amount of Rs.23,63,704/- to the complainant i.e. proprietor of M/s Siya Ram Woolen Industries, Panipat.

Notice of motion for 23.03.2020.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 25.01.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, on his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 20.01.2020, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Dinesh Kumar admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 20.01.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
